


## Pilgrim House Conference Centre

The Conference Centre is part of our church facilities and is located in the centre of Canberra (in Civic, adjacent to the Jolimont Centre).

## UnitingCare Canberra City

Through our location as a city church we seek to respond to the needs of Canberra.

We have established an Early Morning Centre in the City in partnership with the ACT Department of Disability, Housing and Community Services.



The aim of the centre is to assist those who are homeless or experiencing the effects of disadvantage.

The Early Morning Centre is open each week day

- 7.30am to 8.30am - Free breakfast
- 9.00am to 11.30am - Support and referral services

and provides:

- Office facilities - desk, phone, computer with Internet access
- Post Office Box address and safe collection point for mail.

The centre operates under the banner of UnitingCare the nation-wide community services arm of the Uniting Church.
