Resumption of Gathered Services on 23 August 2020

There will be a gathered service next Sunday 23 August 2020 at 10.00am

Initially the numbers will be limited to a maximum of 40 people in the congregation.

Based on our initial experience with the small numbers we hope to be able to raise the limit over time. There will be no morning tea and no singing initially and of course people will need to practice appropriate social distancing.

You need to "register" prior to Sunday so that we do not exceed this maximum number.
